Copying the text

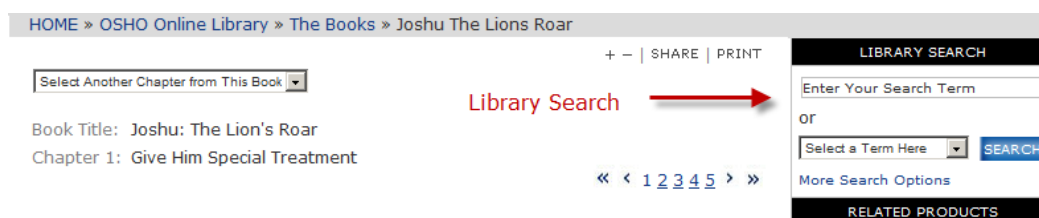

As you can imagine, audiochecking and transcribing thousands of hours of speech inevitably includes errors. Over time, every recording is being double checked and mistakes corrected.

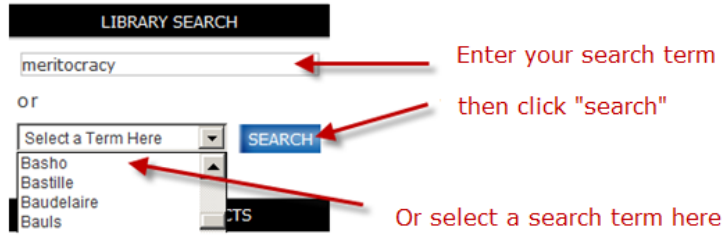

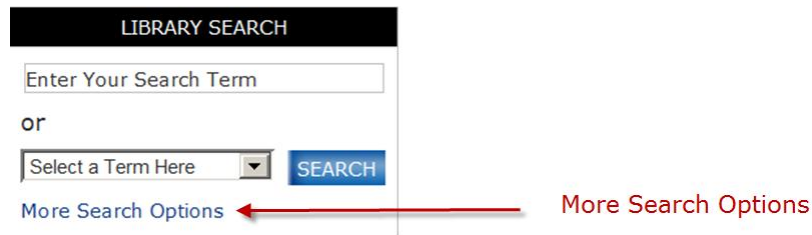

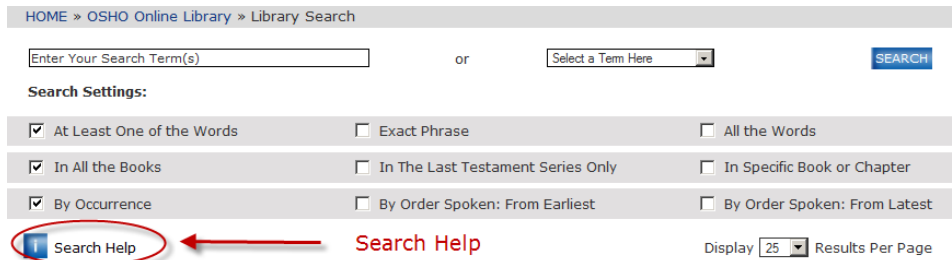
